2016 Scholarship Contest Rules

All entries must be received by mail (postmarked by Feb. 8, 2016), email, fax or dropped off in person by **February 8, 2016** and must follow all contest rules.

The following documents must be submitted as part of this application:

- **Completed Entry Form**
- **Typed Essay**
- **One or Two Typed Community Involvement Paragraphs**

The essay and paragraph(s) on community involvement must be an original work of the applicant and should reflect subjects within the general scope of the essay questions. The essay and paragraph(s) must be typed. The essay cannot be less than 350 words or more than 500 words in length.

Applicant must be a graduating high school senior, attending a two or four year accredited educational institution in the fall of 2016, and an active member of one of the following credit unions:

Badger Globe Evergreen Fox Communities	Community First Prospera St. Elizabeth Employees	Capital Unison	The Labor Verve Winnebago Community
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The applicant must hold an account, in their name, at one of the above credit unions by January 31, 2016. The applicant must obtain verification of membership date by a representative or employee at the credit union of membership (see entry form for signature area). Examples of credit union representatives include tellers, member service representatives, loan representatives, etc.

Members of the Scholarship Award Committee and their families are not eligible.

The Scholarship Award Committee will consist of employees selected from the above participating credit unions. Winners are chosen based on the criteria outlined on the front page of this application. All decisions are final.

All entries are subject to disqualification if they do not meet the above rules and requirements. School and membership requirements will be verified before selection.

Entries must be received or postmarked by the required deadline. Entries received or postmarked after the required deadline will not be eligible for consideration.

Winners will be notified by **March 7, 2016** and scholarships will be presented during the Fox Cities Chapter of Credit Unions meeting at **Pullmans-Trolley Square** the evening of **March 21, 2016**.
